Field Service Activities

Saddleback Home Owner's Association Guest Speaker

Behavior Evaluation Training

Shelter sent five staff members to the Placer SPCA for a behavior evaluation refresher course taught by Matt Green, Operations Director for the PSPCA. Cats and dogs are behavior evaluated, temperament tested, for aggression and behavior before they are placed up for adoption.

Gold Country Faire

Placer Co Animal Services had a booth at the Gold Country Faire earlier this month. The Faire ran from Thursday, Sept. 6 thru the 9th.

Paving the Parking Lot

Front parking lot of shelter to be paved. Paving to begin on Sunday 10/7 and finish on Monday, 10/8, Columbus Day. Staff will have to clear the parking lot and enter shelter through back.

Animal Shelter Cabling Project

Going to be installing conduits and pull boxes through roof of shelter in order to bring in new voice and data services. This is required to remove the buried cable that is under the blacktop and runs across our front parking lot. AT&T is moving their services off of the power poles and underground. Work will be done on a Sunday.

PCAS Marketing Sub-Committee

Discussed downloading various pamphlets from Red Cross, UAN, HSUS and making up with our logo on them for distribution. Discussed Licensing and Micro chipping Campaign in conjunction with rabies clinics and a shelter event.
